Dear supporting brothers and sisters,

We hope and pray that you are all doing well in Christ Jesus. I am writing to you with this report and prayer list so that you may continue to pray for us always, and so that you may know what the Lord is doing in our "red zone" - an area in dire need of the Gospel.

We continue running the race of faith, always looking to the Author and Finisher of our faith: Christ Jesus.

We are making contacts and discipling believers, going into homes, preaching the Gospel, and teaching the Word of God person by person, one by one, family by family. We went to preach at the home of Carolina's mother (Carolina is a contact of a sister in our church who is very active in evangelism), and Carolina invited her mother, "Irma," to come to our church. Doña Irma, along with her large extended family, has now begun to gather with us from time to time. Please pray that we may witness conversions within this family. When we arrived at the home of Doña Irma, who is the matriarch of several other families (her daughters already have children, so Doña Irma now has grandchildren), we found 12 people waiting for us; they were her daughters and granddaughters. Please pray for them. It is a joy to see how eager they are to learn from the Word of God. We left that day feeling so happy, especially considering that this area is heavily influenced by the worship of "Gaucha Gil."

It is a joy every Sunday to see them arrive for our meetings. Please pray for Irma's family, that they may all be saved and grow in their faith.



In the photo, the woman in the center is Jorgelina, one of Doña Irma's daughters, pictured alongside her own children, all of whom are in need of salvation for their souls. We rejoice, and even weep, at seeing the desire these contacts have to learn more about Christ.

God has many people in these cities that we visit.

Over these past few months, God has granted us the joy of seeing Him add new souls every Sunday, people who come to listen to the Gospel of the Lord. Another contact is a young man named Braian. We first met him last year when we visited the home of a family we hold very dear to read the Bible with them. That day, just last month, Braian asked, "May I listen in and stay with you?" We were absolutely delighted! "Yes!" we replied. "It would be our pleasure!" And so, he stayed and listened to the Bible study. He hails from a small town near Mercedes called Yofre, though he is currently living in Mercedes itself.



We also visit another family; the wife is named Viviana. We continue to share the Gospel with her family, even as Viviana has already professed faith as a believer and is faithful in attending church services. She remains steadfast, faithfully bringing members of her family, one by one, to the church. They are currently being evangelized.

A family within our congregation has taken on the responsibility of teaching the children at our church, and they have already established a dedicated group of kids. These children are growing up so fast, they are now entering their teenage years and are quite grown up! We continue to preach to them and share our personal testimonies with them.

We are continuing our missionary trips to Uruguay, traveling via Brazil. In Artigas, we hold meetings with some fellow believers

and have several contacts who have already professed their acceptance of Christ.

In the province of Corrientes, where Mercedes is located, there are 25 administrative departments (it is a very large province). We believe that in only five of these departments is there currently a small group of believers who still preach the doctrine of the Assurance of Salvation. One department we hope to reach for Christ is called "Concepción." In this town, several people have already professed their acceptance of Christ, by the grace of God. Let us pray for this region, which is in such great need of churches.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

1. That God may continue to grant my family and fellow believers strength, enabling us to remain steadfast and to grow in the ministry, especially as we are engaged in spiritual warfare, as described in Ephesians 6.
2. That He may also provide the resources for us to print high-quality tracts tailored specifically to each location we visit, and that He may provide for the maintenance of our ministry tools, such as our vehicle, which constantly requires repairs due to the wear and tear of our missionary travels for the Lord's work.
3. For the salvation of our contacts and for the continued growth of the church.
4. I wanted to ask you to pray for a \$400 computer, which is an affordable price here. My computer keeps freezing on me constantly. It was difficult to get it running, but it keeps freezing all the time.
