Greetings from the Gbor family in Liberia.

I would love to extend my heartfelt thanks to those who have prayed and continue to pray for and with my ministry and family. Currently, Esther is in Ghana undergoing treatment. She is recovering by the grace of God and needs prayers. Edward is studying in Morocco on the government's scholarship. Edmond is in Monrovia studying as well. They need your prayers as they go through their college education. Also, Emmanuel is finding means to enter college; let's pray for God's divine intervention. Please keep me in your prayers for my health. Due to the nature of my health, I am praying that God will provide us with a vehicle which will better facilitate my travels in doing God's work and even transporting visiting missionaries.

We will be blessed in August, 2026, with the presence of Dr. Wolfe and another Evangelist from the USA who will be with us for a week doing teaching and preaching.

This year's soul winning conference was held in Zahn Bahnla, Nimba county from March 16-22. It was well-attended. Several souls were won to Christ with 160 believers in attendance.

Women's conference

We hosted our women's annual conference in Ganta. There were about 400 women in attendance from several Baptist churches in Liberia. This year we were blessed to have two visiting guests from the USA and Kenya. They both taught and participated in the conference. Our women didn't only learn the Bible, but they were also taught different skills including soap making, tie dye, and many others basic skills that will give them opportunities to minister in their homes and churches.



Our hope is that they will go home and practice those skills to improve their homes and churches. If you want to come over and participate in our women's conference in the future, we would appreciate it greatly. It is usually conducted in March, and it is often held in Ganta, one of Liberia's fastest growing commercial cities.

Deaf School

Presently, the Deaf school program is blessed with 70 students who are being encouraged both spiritually and educationally.

These special servants of Christ are being taught basic skills such as tailoring, weeding, with other skills to be added. Thankfully in January, the president of Liberia visited the deaf work and praised God for the work being done. We are grateful to God for giving us partners to be of help to the Deaf school. They've been instrumental for the building of

the Deaf school, feeding of the deaf, and paying the staff of the Deaf school. We are trusting God for His continual support for the feeding and supply of school materials for the school. Furthermore, to maintain good health, we are praying and trusting God for funding to erect a mini-clinic that will care for the Deaf. We have 70 deaf students for this academic year.

As for the Christian Foundation High School, we have 20 students who accepted Christ in our morning devotions. Easter Celebration

Our Easter week was such a remarkable one. It was graced by the national youth for Christ conference. Many youth from many fundamental Baptist churches assembled in Ganta for a week, teaching, learning and witnessing for Christ. This week was climaxed by two nights of preaching and teaching on the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ Jesus. Thankfully, five souls were baptized.

1. Border Dispute: Currently, there is an ongoing border dispute between Liberia and Guinea. Efforts have been made by the Liberian government and other heads of states but the results are still fruitless. We need God's divine intervention! Join us in praying for calm and peace.
2. Prayers for our family: Please pray for my health, the health of my wife, our children's education, funding for our car project (\$19,000 needed), the women's conference, and farm land for the mission's future .
3. Pray for the deaf school.
