During these past few months, we as a family have been deeply grateful to the Lord for the privilege, a truly great one, of being part of His service. We are investing for eternity in the lives of children, adolescents, young adults, and married couples, both in Cochabamba and in Tolata.



We ask for your prayers for the children and youth of Tolata. Their fathers are men who are prone to heavy drinking, and at times these children suffer violence at their hands; may the Lord protect them. We long to reach their fathers with the Gospel so that they, too, may be transformed.

We also pray for a more sheltered space for our "Happy Hour" gatherings in Tolata, as we currently meet on an outdoor futsal court where the wind and cold can be quite severe, and it is only just the beginning of autumn.



Children's Sunday School

The teachers have begun with great enthusiasm to teach the Word of God; furthermore, our new location features spaces that are perfectly suited for the children. The children are delighted because they now have their own little tables where they can color their lesson worksheets and focus attentively.

OANSA Children's Ministry

We did not launch our OANSA program in Cochabamba this year, as our new location there presents some logistical challenges; however, God willing, we plan to launch it in Tolata instead. Meanwhile, at the church in Anocaire, the program continues to grow with more children joining us, and the leaders are overjoyed by the progress they witness every Saturday.



Youth Ministry

We host a youth ministry in both churches every Saturday. We are deeply committed to each young person who attends, guiding them as they learn about church doctrine, studies that will serve to strengthen and ground their hearts.



Women's Ministry

The sisters are currently engaged in a study of the Gospel of Luke, gathering every Tuesday to learn from the Word of the Lord. Additionally, toward the end of May, they plan to conduct an evangelistic outreach specifically for mothers in the town of Vinto, located 45 minutes outside the city of Cochabamba.



Anocaire Church Ministry

With humble and generous hearts, the brethren continue to serve faithfully in the Lord's work, each carrying out the specific ministries He has entrusted to them. We also held a retreat in Tolata for both churches in February, a time that greatly challenged us as families, during which we conducted a study on the Book of Romans.



Marriage Ministry

Throughout this year, our marriage ministry meetings will focus on the topic of biblical finances. This study is proving to be a great blessing for every couple, equipping us to become good stewards of the resources the Lord provides.

Missions

Our sister Silvia is currently working in the jungles of eastern Bolivia, taking the Word to every community. These times



have become increasingly difficult due to rising gasoline prices and the scarcity of fuel; nevertheless, God has remained faithful to us to this very day.

Omereque Project

By the grace of God, the Jaimes family is greatly encouraged as they continue their work with children and adolescents—and now, as they also engage in preaching the Word to the church congregation. God is faithful in blessing the work they are carrying out in Omereque.



Tolata Project

We are currently working on establishing a venue for pastors’ conferences and camps for the children of pastoral families. We are also hosting “Happy Hour” sessions for the local children and adolescents; they are delighted with the program, and several have already received Christ as their Savior and Lord.
