Over the last three months, we have been working very diligently in the ministry, holding fellowship gatherings with the local churches, as well as ministering to the children in Mazán and the community of San José along the Río Napo. We give thanks to our God, who continues to show us His mercy—specifically toward my wife, whom He has preserved in good health and without physical hindrance. Her good health has enabled us to carry out evangelism and discipleship work during the fellowship gatherings held at every church within our jurisdiction.

We also continue to earnestly ask that you pray for our son, Jesús Daniel; please pray that God may continue to work in his life and protect him from further attacks by the epilepsy that has recently caused him to suffer seizures.

In the month of February, our church in Mazán celebrated its anniversary; during this event, nine people accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior.

Brothers and sisters, please pray for our children's ministry, which we conduct every Saturday and Sunday. Through this ministry, we provide discipleship training to the children who accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior during the evangelistic campaign held in February—an event that proved to be a tremendous blessing.



In the month of March, we conducted an evangelistic outreach specifically for the children of Mazán and the children of the San José community; we were blessed to have 167 children in attendance.

In April, a fellowship of churches was held in the community of Yanamono, under the theme, "Traps in the Church." (Amos 3:3;

Philippians 3:15) We rejoice that several baptisms also took place during this special time together.

On April 16th, I joined a medical outreach campaign which visited three villages along the Amazon River to conduct evangelism over a period of five days. Please continue to pray for these villages and for the believers there.
