Blessings, dear brothers and sisters! It is a joy to be able to communicate with you through this letter and to share the blessings of God's work in northern Argentina.

We are always grateful for your prayers and your support, which are a source of great help and encouragement as we continue to serve our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

We give thanks continually for what the Lord provides for us each month; thank you very much.

La Gracia Baptist Church (Tucumán): Starting in March, we resumed our activities after passing through January and February—the traditional vacation months—during which the church focuses on camps.

In March, we resumed our Sunday School activities, where the church is currently studying the book of James.

We also restarted classes for the Bible Institute, as well as Discipleship classes for those who are new to the faith; this ministry is instrumental in fostering the growth of the brothers and sisters who join our church family.

Regarding the Bible Institute, in May we were blessed with a visit from Brother Charles and Sister Joan Farley from the IPM Education Department, who taught a course on Biblical Counseling. We are deeply grateful to God for this time, which proved to be a great blessing for the church members and their spiritual growth; we are equally grateful to God for the brothers and sisters who traveled from so far away to assist the church.



I would like to request your prayers for Cristina Alarcón, a sister in our congregation who recently underwent surgery after a tumor was discovered; we are praying earnestly for her recovery. Please also pray for Pablo and Meli—a married couple who, along with their son Tomás, are growing in their faith within the church. Pablo's mother recently suffered a stroke and required hospitalization; however, she has since recovered and, remarkably, attended our church for the very first time.

Fe Baptist Church (Rosario de la Frontera): Our activities here have been quite similar, as we hold our camps and retreats jointly with La Gracia Baptist Church. However, the church is currently engaged in a great deal of ministry work with children on Saturdays through our "Happy Hour" and Bible Club programs, sharing the Gospel with the children while simultaneously seeking to reach out to their parents.



Regarding the Institute: Brother Charles and his wife, Joan, who assisted with translation, taught a course on Biblical Counseling to the church members. It was an excellent time of edification for both the church body and the individual believers.

We continue to long to make progress on the construction of our sanctuary, specifically regarding the flooring and the interior plastering.

I would like to ask for your prayers for Maximiliano, a 27-year-old young man. He is the son of José and Anabella Aciar, a couple who serve as leaders within our church. Their son has undergone several heart surgeries and is currently in the recovery process.

Regarding our ministry to the churches in the mountain regions and indigenous communities: We have received several invitations, to Valle Colorado in September and to Cusi Cusi in November. We are praying to gather the necessary resources and secure a vehicle so that we can reach these locations; we earnestly request your prayers, as we are in need of a pickup truck to transport us there. I know this represents a significant financial undertaking, but we trust in the Lord that He will provide. It is a critical necessity, for without such a vehicle, we are unable to reach the churches of our indigenous brothers and sisters. The specific amount we are praying for is \$20,000; we place our full confidence in the provision of our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

I would like to express my gratitude to God—and to you, our brothers and sisters—for the assistance provided to repair the roof of our home. We are deeply thankful. God is good; thank you, brothers.

Brothers and sisters, we are always grateful that you take the time to read our letters. We pray for you, for your church, and for your country.

Prayer Requests:

1. For our health: that the Lord would grant us the strength to continue serving Him. I am still experiencing stomach issues, but we trust that we will make a full recovery; we place our confidence in His grace.
2. Regarding our personal support: we are unable to fully cover our budget, but we are deeply grateful for what we do receive, which is a tremendous help.
3. For the interior plastering of the church: \$1,300.
4. For floor repairs: \$1,300.
5. Tires for our vehicle: \$400.
6. For the purchase of the pickup truck, the cost is \$20,000.
