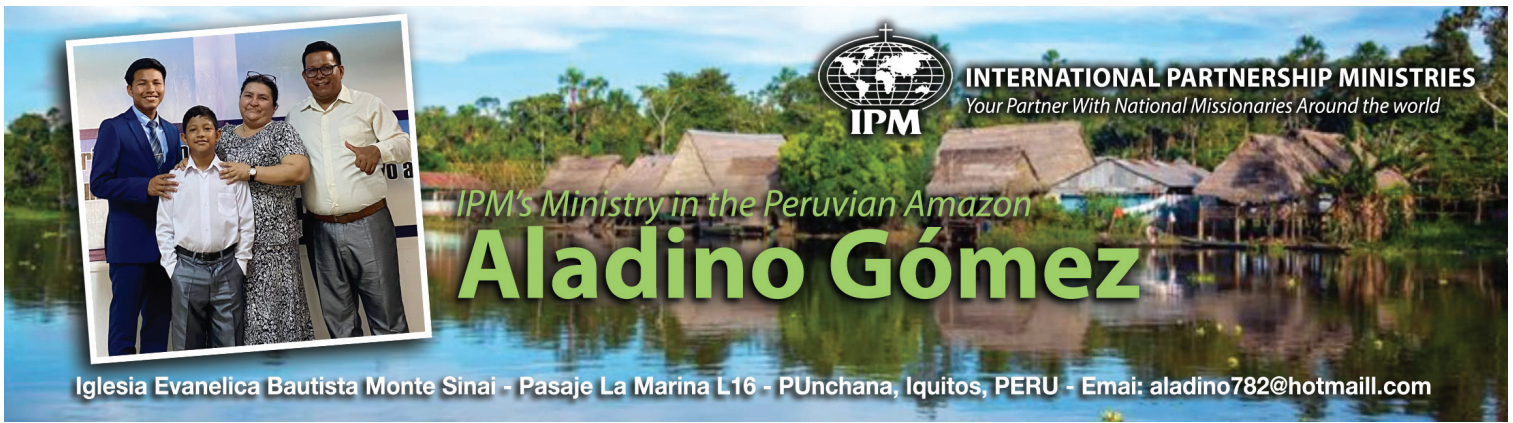




Good morning, my dear brothers and sisters.

May God's grace and favor be with each of us and fulfill His purposes in our lives for His glory. Please accept warm greetings from the hot city of Iquitos and from the Gómez Tuanama missionary family.

By God's grace, we continue working in the church and in missions here in the Peruvian Amazon. As for my family: my little Jabes Abdiel is in his fifth year of primary school; my daughter Almendra Pierina is continuing her theological studies at Libertad Theological Seminary and also works there as a secretary; my son Kerwin Gregorio finished his theological studies last year and is working in the Lord's vineyard as a missionary and preacher at our beloved Monte Sinai Church, as well as serving as a teacher at Libertad Theological Seminary; and my wife, Fe Tuanama, is on the seminary's teaching staff, though she is currently dealing with health issues—specifically, she needs surgery on both eyes. By God's grace, we are all busy with the work of our God.

Regarding physical facilities, the Monte Sinai church building has undergone renovations, and construction work is ongoing. Spiritually, we carry out various activities, including youth fellowship gatherings; recently, we were visited by Pastor Igor Araujo from Arequipa, accompanied by Pastors Bryan and Cristian Pease.

Over the past three months, we have conducted study modules at the seminary and undertaken missionary trips to practice personal evangelism in the Huitoto native communities of Tierra Firme and Puerto Rico de Barranquilla. We also dedicated the new church building for the Maranatha congregation in Puerto Rico de Barranquilla, where four believers took the step of obedience through baptism.

Additionally, we held a medical outreach campaign in partnership with the Rebecca International ministry, led by Dr. Bill Brown; we visited four remote communities where people received medical care and heard the Word of God.

Note: We are holding a youth camp in San Pedro de Huashalado from August 5th to 8th.
