Singing, teaching, preaching, and sharing a meal filled the program on April 5, 2026. We also had the joy of baptizing a 43-year-old Deaf man that day. His name is Djezou Koffi Gervais, and he has been attending our community for five years now.

There were approximately 14 missionaries from the Port-Bouet 2 church. Pray for the effectiveness of the missionaries in the field.

ETHIOPIA

The mission in Gambella is going well. Everything has been quiet, but not peaceful, with the Anyuak tribe since the situation occurred in January, 2026.

Nine souls were saved, comprising 3 hearing and 6 deaf. Among this group is a 9-year-old boy, an 11-year-old girl, an older lady, and her hearing daughter. The ministry is praying that this older lady will be able to learn more sign language.

Gambella's government has banned the use of motorcycles, allowing only a few cars to travel, but even those are few. We are suffering from having to walk because it's hard to find a ride.

PRAYER REQUESTS

Please pray with them, they need a water tank because there is no water for people to buy from the trucks that bring it from the rivers. The big tank will cost about \$600 plus.
