As many of you know and have been praying for my oldest daughter, her pregnancy and delivery were complicated, but twins came into our lives. Thank the Lord, they are growing very well. Now we have the news, and we ask for your prayers for our youngest daughter. She is expecting her baby in May and is also facing a somewhat complicated pregnancy. She didn't know she was pregnant and was in the mountains of Chile with a team of soldiers for snow training. When she returned, she wasn't feeling well. She went to the doctor, and they
