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Dear brothers and sisters,

It is a pleasure to greet you in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I thank the Lord for your constant prayers for my family, for the work here in Peru, Indiana, and for all the trips we make throughout the Amazon and along the Napo River. Thank you very much, my brothers, for praying for my health and that of my family.

I have just returned from a missionary tour of the "White Fields" area, located seven hours from the Mazan District. We visited two communities: first, Lagarto Chocha, which has a population of 300; during this visit, 35 people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior. We are following up with them because this is a field where the Gospel has not yet reached. Second, Puerto Alegre, with a population of 280; there, 30 people accepted Christ as their personal Savior—among them was the *Apu* (community leader) and his entire family. Please pray for Denis and his family, and I also ask for your prayers for Pastor Óscar, who is helping the brethren with teaching.

Brothers, we need your help—both through prayer and financial support—to purchase necessary materials such as Bibles, hymnals, and supplies for working with children. We also need funds for food and fuel to continue visiting the brethren, as well as for medicines; they are far removed from first aid or clinical treatment, and many children suffer from malnutrition and vitamin deficiencies, as well as parasitic infections and anemia—conditions that affect adults as well.

I share this need regarding the Napo River area; we are planning another trip for August 15th. I ask for your prayers that God provides the necessary funds—\$2,800—to carry out this missionary journey for the glory of God. The people along the Napo River need the Gospel; there are still villages along the river that we have yet to evangelize. It is my desire to continue visiting these communities that do not know the Gospel. Please help me through your prayers so that God provides everything we need and covers the required expenses.

Thank you, my beloved brothers and sisters, for supporting us with your prayers and financial contributions. May God bless you all greatly. I also thank those who have been able to come to be with us here in the Peruvian Amazon; thank you for working together in the ministry of our Lord Jesus Christ. Thank you for supporting our missionary trips, every two months throughout the Amazon and every four months along the Napo River. May our good God continue to bless you.

Additionally, I ask for prayers for my daughter, Esther, who works with the children; please pray for her needs and that God opens doors of blessing so she can cover the cost of materials. She is also training sisters from the churches to work with the children in their own congregations across the Amazon and Napo River regions.
