We are always thankful to the Lord who is continuously helping us in His Almighty Power and Love. The work in Debrebirhan and the surrounding area is steadily growing. There is a daily evangelism in our city. In the last three months, 150 people received evangelistic tracts, literatures, and New Testaments. Please pray for many of them to come to hear more about how they can be saved.

The outreach to the nearby village town of Chacha continued. One of us is going to the place three times a week and we are seeing good reports, people are taking evangelistic literature, and three people are coming to Church every Sunday. It is 20 kilometers away from Debrebirhan. There are many who have shown interest to come to Church and we plan to plant a church there.

We thank God for the two new people who are following discipleship lessons and eight more people who showed interest to be enrolled soon.

The Saturday teenagers teaching and gathering has proven helpful in helping them grow in grace and understanding of the truth. Please pray for many young people to come and get spiritual help and grow in grace among us.

All the outreach places and Church planting endeavors are going very well, please pray for the help of God to reach many and to plant many Churches around the area.
