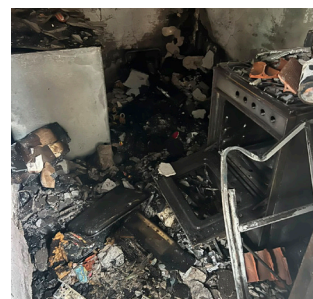

Blessings, dear brothers and sisters. We are writing to you once again to share the blessings of God's work in Northern Argentina. We are grateful for your prayers and financial support, which are a great help in advancing the missionary work here.

Regarding the work at **La Gracia Baptist Church in Tucumán**, I received a phone call on Monday the 27th informing me that a fire had broken out at the church. When I arrived, we found that a fire had indeed occurred at the rear of the building, affecting the dining area and the restroom. The epicenter was the kitchen, which was completely destroyed; everything inside burned, as did the roofs of the dining area and the restroom. Thankfully, the losses were strictly material.

We thank God for the neighbors who helped quickly; thanks to them and the arrival of the firefighters, the fire was brought under control and did not spread to the main sanctuary. After an investigation by the authorities, it was determined that the problem started due to an electrical fault, as the electrical wiring had completely burned out. Despite this sad and painful news, we have seen God's hand of care; the sanctuary suffered no damage whatsoever—everything remains intact—and we were able to hold our Sunday service, though we could not use the restrooms or the affected areas.

I should mention that the premises where the church meets are on loan to us for our gatherings. We have been using the space for 17 years, and the owners have been understanding about the situation, recognizing that the incident was not our fault. We have already begun the reconstruction process; we are committed to moving forward, understanding that all things work together for the good of the believer. I ask for your prayers. We are not discouraged, but we face the responsibility of replacing what was destroyed by the fire, and we trust in the provision of our Savior.



Faith Baptist Church (Rosario de la Frontera) We are continuing with church activities, Sunday school, meetings, and visitation, as well as construction work on the sanctuary.

Regarding visitation, one fruit of these efforts is that Mariana has started attending church with her two children; the sisters are working on her spiritual growth, and we are praying for her parents' salvation. Another special activity we held was a couples' meeting; 22 couples attended, a significant turnout, given how difficult it can be to gather couples due to their busy schedules and work commitments. God is good, and we enjoyed an excellent time of spiritual edification through the Word. Three couples attended for the first time, Pablo and Melina, Irma and Carlos, and Adriana and Lalo, giving them the opportunity to hear the Word and the plan of salvation.



Regarding our ministry in the mountains and among indigenous communities, we have been invited to visit Valle Colorado in September and Cusi Cusi in November. We are praying for the necessary resources and a suitable vehicle, as the roads are very challenging. We need a pickup truck capable of transporting us and our supplies.

As I mentioned in my previous letter regarding our prayer requests, after much prayer, we have recognized the need to purchase a pickup truck. We know this is a major undertaking, but we trust the Lord to provide. It is a critical need; without it, we cannot reach the churches of our indigenous brothers and sisters.



We are praying for a total of \$20,000, trusting in the provision of our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.

Brothers and sisters, we are always grateful that you take the time to read our letter. We pray for you, your church, and your country.
