We hope you are doing well and enjoying the abundant spiritual life found in Christ.

I am writing to share a little about us and our ministry. Thank God, I was able to travel with my son, Josias, to the town of Concepción, where we preached, evangelized, and made visits; I will soon be doing the same in Uruguay, a place we visit regularly.



Here in Mercedes, the work continues to grow; church attendance is rising, and we need more chairs. As always, my entire family is involved in the various ministries, which is a great blessing. Josias has a website and a YouTube channel where he preaches through entire books of the Bible; currently, he uploads 12-minute teachings on the Book of Colossians every Wednesday. My other son, Joao, also has a gift for understanding and explaining entire books of God's Word, and he shares this with the brethren.

My wife, Maria, opens doors for us to enter people's homes; she has a special gift, women, in particular, respect and love her. She helps the sisters (and women we are in contact with) with their spiritual and other needs.



Together, we also conduct Bible studies in people's homes. Last night, Thursday, August 14th, we held a Bible study at the home of Antonio and his mother, Maria, who prepared *tortas fritas* for us to eat. We had a wonderful spiritual time, as both Antonio and his mother are believers. Many people visit that home, and we share our testimony of Christ with them; a few days ago, Maria celebrated her birthday and invited many guests, including my family, and publicly testified to her faith in Christ.

Ernesto and Gladis are responsible for teaching God's Word to the children of the church, doing so with great zeal and love. Rosita and her children, Lázaro, Isaac, and others, attend the gatherings at Ernesto and Gladis's home. They have been hearing the Gospel for years and now attend Bible classes; they are children we love, Isaac and Lazaro. We want them to be saved and to continue gathering with the church as they grow older. They have a great need for Christ, as they do not have a father; they only have their mother and God, our Heavenly Father.

A few days ago, a brother who was very dear to my family passed away and went into the presence of the Lord in the city of Rivera. I found out shortly after he passed and immediately organized a trip to Rivera with Josias. However, about 15 kilometers outside the city of Mercedes, my car engine overheated again and the head gasket blew. We had to turn back and barely managed to reach a mechanic in Mercedes; we were unable to be with the brethren in Rivera.

Thank God we have fixed the engine, though there are still some other details we are sorting out so we can travel to Uruguay.

We thank God for the brothers and sisters who are a great help to the work through their gifts, Silvia's family: Juan, his wife, their daughter Juanita, and Gregorio. Silvia is a teacher; she recently earned her degree via Zoom.

Lorena continues to preach to her large family in the countryside, her sisters and her 94-year-old





grandmother. We also preach to them whenever we see them, and the other part of her family living in the city is listening to the Gospel. New souls are always coming in, such as Mrs. Maria Paula, and others continue to arrive as well.

It is winter here and very rainy, but thanks to the Lord and your help and prayers, God's work continues to grow in our area. As you know, God's work, the ministry, the preaching, the church, and evangelism based on the pure, biblical Gospel of grace, is sacred to us. Wherever we are, we exalt Christ, the Redeemer of souls.
