We were also invited by two churches in the area to minister—myself to the congregation, and Schumayk to the women.

We thank the Lord for the wonderful opportunities we had in Erreterria to share the Gospel and encourage the believers, who had recently faced several disheartening challenges.

It is a joy to see them pressing forward, and to witness the return of some individuals who had been away from the church for a long time.

Upon returning to Barcelona, we took the opportunity to serve at our home church; Schumayk, our daughter Yonit, and I all taught at various gatherings.

It was also a joy to help out for a week with a children's activity at a church in Barcelona. Brother and missionary Martin Valcarcel (formerly a pastor at a Hispanic church in Decatur) had just passed away to be with the Lord, and his son Josué, who is a pastor here, had to make an urgent trip to the U.S. We were able to step in and cover that church activity for him, a truly great blessing.

In August, we will also be helping out at the church in Tarragona, as the pastoral family, the Segurados, will be taking some time to rest. Meanwhile, our daughter, Yonit, will be on an evangelistic trip to Northern Ireland.

We look forward with joy to visiting three churches in southern Spain this August, as well as visiting my family, who live in the Andalusia region, and sharing the Gospel with them.

We had previously called off this long trip because the car's air conditioning broke down and the repair was too expensive. But since our Heavenly Master sets everything right, a brother in the faith heard about our need and fixed the problem for us for free. So, we will be able to make the trip. What a faithful and wonderful God we have!

Our prayer requests are: that the Lord continues to use us to bless the work in Spain, to edify our brothers and sisters, and to evangelize the Latinos and Muslim foreigners we encounter.





Please pray for my wife, Schumayk; she is preparing lessons for children and teenagers on how to face the attacks they may encounter from the world around them as Christians.

We are in need of help and prayer. I had to get new glasses this week because I could barely see to read anymore, and I have started losing vision in my left eye. The cost is \$800. We do not know if surgery will be required in the future.



Pray also for our Jewish friends, that we may continue to encourage them and lead them to Christ. Thank you, thank you, beloved brothers and sisters, for your prayers and your financial support! The churches and ministries in Spain do not always have the financial means to cover travel and accommodation costs, so your help is invaluable.
