Greetings from the city of Iquitos! We are very happy to be part of the IPM family.

By God's grace, we continue working in the Lord's vineyard in the ministry He entrusted to us. As part of the Mount Sinai Church, we launched the Mount Sinai Bible Institute in Iquitos on August 25, with 20 students. We currently hold theology classes twice a week at this location; meanwhile, our bi-monthly classes continue in San Pedro de Huashalado. I also have a vision to establish another connection in the Bora community of Pucaurquillo next year. This is a location that requires a 24-hour round-trip boat journey along the Amazon River. By God's grace, I have the help of my wife, Fe, and my children, Kerwin and Pierina, who are instrumental in carrying out the Institute's ministry.

Another ministry I am leading involves youth camps. In August, we held a camp in San Pedro de Huashalado, hosting many young people from both the city of Iquitos and the rural communities. Seven young people decided to serve the Lord and enrolled in the Mount Sinai Bible Institute.

Currently, students from the Mount Sinai Bible Institute are supporting local Baptist churches in their activities. Since 80% of the students are young people who rely on their parents for support, we need financial assistance for travel costs so we can continue spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We have scheduled visits to five communities belonging to the Huitoto, Bora, Ocaina, and Yagua ethnic groups. These communities are located along the Ampiyacu and Yahuasyacu Rivers. The goal is to conduct evangelism outreaches and children's campaigns during the Christmas season.

I thank God for your prayers and financial support, which helps to meet both spiritual and material needs. Together, we are joining forces to support new works in Amazonian villages and build sanctuaries where people can gather to worship the Lord. We are currently ministering in the communities of Sancudo and Yanamono.

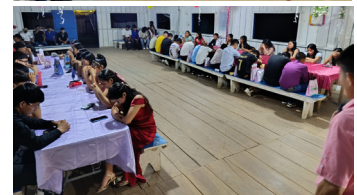
